## Hamburg Sustainability Conference 2026

**The Hamburg Sustainability Conference (HSC) brings together international leaders from politics, business, science and civil society to forge new alliances and accelerate progress toward the United Nations 2030 Agenda. Following its first two successful editions in 2024 and 2025, the third HSC will take place on 29–30 June 2026—again at the Hamburg Chamber of Commerce and Hamburg City Hall.**

In times of mounting geopolitical crises, the Hamburg Sustainability Conference fosters multilateral cooperation and helps to rebuild trust. As global commitment to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) falters, the conference convenes key stakeholders from all relevant sectors to create new synergies and generate fresh momentum. A central priority is the meaningful engagement of the private sector. Through tailored formats and its innovative co-creation approach, the HSC provides space for bold decisions and large-scale solutions.

HSC 2026 will revolve around three thematic pillars: Resilient Economies, Technology and the Future of Our Planet; Risk, Uncertainty and Conflict; and Ensuring the Future of Human Collaboration: Multilateralism and Governance. By addressing key challenges and opportunities at the intersection of economic resilience, technological innovation, and global governance, the HSC strives to offer an aspirational vision of sustainability that ensures human and planetary wellbeing, firmly grounded in co-operation, multilateralism, and investment in global goods.
